NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERE TO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

CLAUSE 1
CO-OPERATION

- 1.1 Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will enhance and benchmark the job-aligned skills of the students from the Institution.

CLAUSE 2

CLAUSE 3 INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

- 3.1 Nothing contained in this MOU shall, by express grant, implication, estoppel or otherwise, create in either Party any right, title, interest, or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to know-how, inventions, patents, copy rights and designs) of the other Party.

CLAUSE 4 VALIDITY

- 4.1 This Agreement will be valid till 24th June 2024 or until otherwise it is expressly terminated by either Party on mutually agreed terms, during which period AEP CERTIFICATION, the Second Party, as the case may be, will take effective steps for implementation of this MOU based on the requirement exclusively expressed by the First Party. 1. Preamble:

This memorandum of understanding thereafter referred to as MoU is prepared and executed on this 08 May 2021 at the Institute, Sri Indu College of Engineering and Technology, Hyderabad, India.

2. Scope of collaboration:

- Assignments including MCQs and Coding Questions for the specified topic.
- Test/Exam module based on the understanding of that topic.
- Discussion forum for students to interact among themselves.
- Doubt section where the mentors can clear doubts of the students.
- Leaderboard for students to analyze their performance.
- Progress bar for students to track their progress.
- Faculty dashboard where the faculty can monitor progress of entire class/specific students.
- Certificates to all the students crossing 60% completion mark on the course.

3. Role of Sri Indu College of Engineering and Technology:

1. Sri Indu College of Engineering and Technology will encourage the faculty handling programming courses and students to effectively use the Coding Ninjas platform to enhance problem solving skills and to inculcate a coding culture among students.

4. Role of Coding Ninjas:

1. Coding Ninjas will provide all facilities mentioned in clause 2.

6. Financial aspects:

1. Coding Ninjas will provide all facilities mentioned under clause 2 completely free of cost for as many students as Sri Indu wants to enroll.
2. 7. Content Rights:

The content provided should not be distributed to other organisations or on public platforms without prior consent of Coding Ninjas.

8. Validity:

1. This MoU will remain valid for a period of 1 year from the date of signing of the agreement with provision for yearly review by the CACC.
2. During the tenure of the MoU or thereafter, Sri Indu will be free to take similar or same type of work independently and will be free to enter into similar MoU with other parties.

9. Confidentiality Obligation:

1. 





4.3. **ILPL** may terminate this Agreement in the event the Data Science club Partner fails to perform its obligations mentioned herein in this Agreement and any other reasonable instructions issued by **ILPL** from time to time.

4.4. Either Party shall have the right to terminate this Agreement vide a prior written notice of (thirty) 30 days to the other Party.

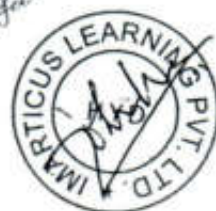

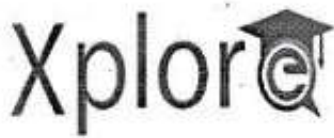

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING ("MOU")

This MOU is made and executed on this 20th day of January, 2021, by & between:

MANAC INFOTECH PVT LIMITED here in after referred to as "**MANAC INFOTECH**" is Information Technology Company offering a wide range of services and solutions both in India and abroad. These include System Design and Development, Systems Engineering, Multi-vendor Networking, Consultancy, Installation, Total Facilities management, Training etc. **MANAC INFOTECH PVT LIMITED** having its registered office at **Liberty, Hyderabad.**

AND

Sri Indu college of Engg & Tech hereinafter referred to as "**SICET**" run by the Loyola Educational Society, is situated at Sheriguda(V), Ibrahimpatnam(M), RangaReddy(D), Telangana-501510 the College endeavors to impart quality education in the Engineering & Management fields, to all Sections of the society.

1. PREAMBLE

Information Technology (IT) has revolutionized the modern world and is expected to bring in sweeping changes in a host of human activities in the future. Information Technology is now an indispensable tool in every business industry, trade, commercial enterprise and educational institutions.

In the interest of having a healthy industry – academia interaction **SICET** and **MANAC INFOTECH** have decided to work together to organize IT related projects and courses in information technology. The main aim is to spread proficiency in information technology and also provide an industry experience to students of **SICET.**

2. SCOPE

The IT industry, today, is poised to provide employment to fresh engineering graduates in large numbers owing to tremendous growth. However, most students fail to meet the entry criteria of the industry primarily due to lack of industry exposure. It has therefore become imperative for academic institutions to provide industry orientation skills to both students and teaching staff so that the practical application of theoretical concepts is well understood by the students. In order to achieve this objective, **MANAC INFOTECH** and **SICET** have decided to enter into this MoU as per mutually agreed terms and conditions.

3. STRUCTURE OF PROGRAMMES

The Agreement is planned to provide a platform to **MANAC INFOTECH**, to offer the IT/software (JAVA & .NET related) projects, Aptitude Training and provide necessary guidance for placements.

3.1 CONDUCTING IT RELATED PROJECTS AND COURSES IN MANAC INFOTECH RESPECTIVE CENTERS

MANAC INFOTECH will identify and provide IT related projects and courses in **MANAC INFOTECH** respective centers. **MANAC INFOTECH** will also identify the resources required along with timeframes for the completion of the projects and courses. **MANAC INFOTECH** will identify suitable project coordinators and depute them as required. The project coordinators will act as mentors and guide the students/staff in all phases of the projects and courses.

Deliverables from **MANAC INFOTECH** & **SICET**:

- **MANAC INFOTECH** will conduct the training sessions on related technology the detailed schedule is enclosed in Annexure A.

- **MANAC INFOTECH** will conduct an evaluation on completion of the projects which will include presentation and Viva Voice for the students.
- **MANAC INFOTECH** will provide certification for students who complete the and projects successfully.
- **MANAC INFOTECH** may help the eligible candidates with the placements opportunities based on the clients requirement.
- **MANAC INFOTECH** will consistently endeavor to elevate **SICET** to a "Centre of Excellence" in which ever way possible within the limitations of **MANAC INFOTECH**.
- **SICET** will provide infrastructure facilities (i.e. HW, SW, etc) for conducting the projects.
- **SICET** will identify project coordinators for the projects along with the teams of students. The project coordinator will liaise with **MANAC INFOTECH** in all aspects of the projects.

3.2 Joint responsibility of MANAC INFOTECH and SICET

MANAC INFOTECH and **SICET** will mutually and decide the project titles, scope of work, duration, resources required and other modalities before the commencement of the programs.

3.3 CONFIDENTIALITY

Both the parties agree to maintain confidentiality of information and the information can be released only with mutual agreement.

3.4 INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

Intellectual Property Rights' means all rights in inventions, patents, copyrights, design rights, trademarks and trade names, service marks, trade Secrets, knowhow and other intellectual property rights (whether registered or unregistered) and all applications for any of them, actual or pending anywhere in the world.

By entering into this MOU, the parties undertake:

- 1) To protect each other's intellectual property,
- 2) Not to use each other's intellectual property without the prior written consent,
- 3) ensure the confidentiality of such intellectual property within their respective organizations,
- 4) Not to use each other's intellectual property should this arrangement be dissolved. The Parties agree that neither of them shall gain by virtue of this MOU any rights of ownership of copyrights, patents, trade Secrets, trade marks, or any other intellectual property rights owned by the other Party.

3.5 TERM & TERMINATION

This arrangement shall remain in force for a period of 60 days from the date of signing and can be terminated by giving a written notice period of 15 days by either party.

Each party shall have the right to terminate this Agreement, by a prior notice of 15 days in writing to the other party upon the occurrence of any of the following events;

- a) If either party commits any willful breach of any terms stipulated in this Agreement and has failed to rectify the same within notice period of 30 days. The parties shall be responsible for conducting the training for the students enrolled before the termination of the contract.
- b) If either party enters into liquidation whether compulsory or voluntary (save for the purpose of amalgamation or reconstruction) or makes an assignment for the benefit of or compounds with its credit or so has a Manager or Receiver appointed in respect of all or any part of its business or a petition for winding-up or judicial management is presented against the other party or the other party ceases to carry on any part of its business or threatens to do any of these things.

On the expiry or termination of this Agreement, all rights and obligations of the parties shall automatically terminate except; -for such rights of actions that have accrued prior to such termination and any obligations, which expressly or by implication are intended to come into or continue in force.

4. FORCE MAJEURE

Neither Party shall be liable for any default or delay in the performance of its obligations if and to the extent such default is caused, directly or indirectly, by fires, floods, power failures, Acts of God, act of public enemy, civil commotion, sabotage, wars, insurrections, riots, labour disturbances, strikes, lockouts, go-

slow, damage to machinery on account of accident or passing of any statutory order by the eligible authority/ies, prohibiting performance of such obligation by a competent authority; and restrictions of any country affecting the performance of this agreement or any part hereof. In the event of the occurrence of any of the foregoing, the date of performance will be deferred for a period of time equal to the time lost by reason of the delay. The affected party shall intimate the other party within reasonable time period of such occurrences.

LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the Agreement, in no event shall either Party be liable, whether in contract, tort, or otherwise, for special, punitive, indirect or consequential damages, including, without limitation, loss of profits or revenues arising under or in connection with this Agreement even if such Party has been advised in advance of their possibility. The Total Liability of MANAC INFOTECH shall be limited to the total fee received under the Agreement.

6. DISPUTE RESOLUTION MECHANISM

Any lack of understanding to the spirit and implementation of this Agreement will be resolved by mutual consultation by the Parties. In case parties fail to resolve the dispute by mutual consultation within 30 days of rising of dispute, the same will be resolved through Arbitration in terms of clause 7 below.

7. ARBITRATION

In case the dispute remains unresolved, the same shall be referred to the Arbitration in accordance with Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 after giving the notice of such reference to the other party. The matter shall be referred to the sole Arbitrator mutually appointed by the parties. In case the parties fail to appoint the sole arbitrator, the same shall be appointed by the High Court of the concerned State. The venue of the arbitration shall be Hyderabad and the language preferred will be English. The award of the sole Arbitrator shall be final and binding on the parties.

8. GOVERNING LAW

This MOU shall be governed and construed in accordance with the laws of India and the courts of Hyderabad shall have the exclusive jurisdiction to entertain any dispute or suit arising out of or in relation to this Agreement.

9. AMENDMENT

No amendment to this agreement is valid unless signed by a persons duly authorized by the parties.

10. Non-Exclusivity:

Nothing in this Agreement shall mean nor shall be construed to mean that **MANAC INFOTECH** is precluded from entering into any arrangement with any

third party for same or similar purpose, at any time, including without limitation, with any competitor or potential competitor of SICET.

11. No Agency

The Parties have entered into this Agreement as independent entities and nothing in this Agreement creates a relationship of employer and employee, principal and agent, joint venture pooling arrangement partnership or formal business organization of any kind between the Parties.

12. Publicity:

No Party shall use the name of the other party in any publicity or press release without first obtaining the prior written approval of such other Party to the content of such publicity or press release.

13. Non-Solicitation:

Neither party shall directly or indirectly solicit the employment of any employee of each other during the continuity of this Agreement and two years after the termination/expiration of this Agreement.
