ACADEMIC RULES, REGULATIONS, COURSE STRUCTURE UNDER AUTONOMOUS STATUS FOR THE BATCHES OF STUDENTS UNDER U.G. AND P.G. PROGRAMMES TO BE ADMITTED FROM THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2018 – 19.

Resolution: The members have approved the Academic Rules, Regulations and Course structure under Autonomous status for the batches of students under U.G. and P.G. Programmes to be admitted from the academic year 2018-19 with the following amendments.

i) For MBA and M.Tech the Mid Theory Examinations will be conducted for 30 marks. The Part-A consisting of 5 questions as compulsory carrying 2 marks each. The Part -B consisting of 5 questions where any 4 questions are to be answered. Each question carries 5 marks.

ii) For MBA practical subjects, 100 marks will be allotted as internal examination. Whereas for M.Tech (CSE/CS), 30 marks will be allotted for day-to-day performance which is treated as internal examination and 70 marks will be allotted for External End Examination.

iii) Theory End Examinations will be conducted for 70 marks for both M.B.A and M.Tech (CSE/CS). The Part-A consisting of 5 questions, each carrying 4 marks where all the questions are compulsory. The Part -B consisting of 10 questions where 1 question from every unit needed to be answered.
