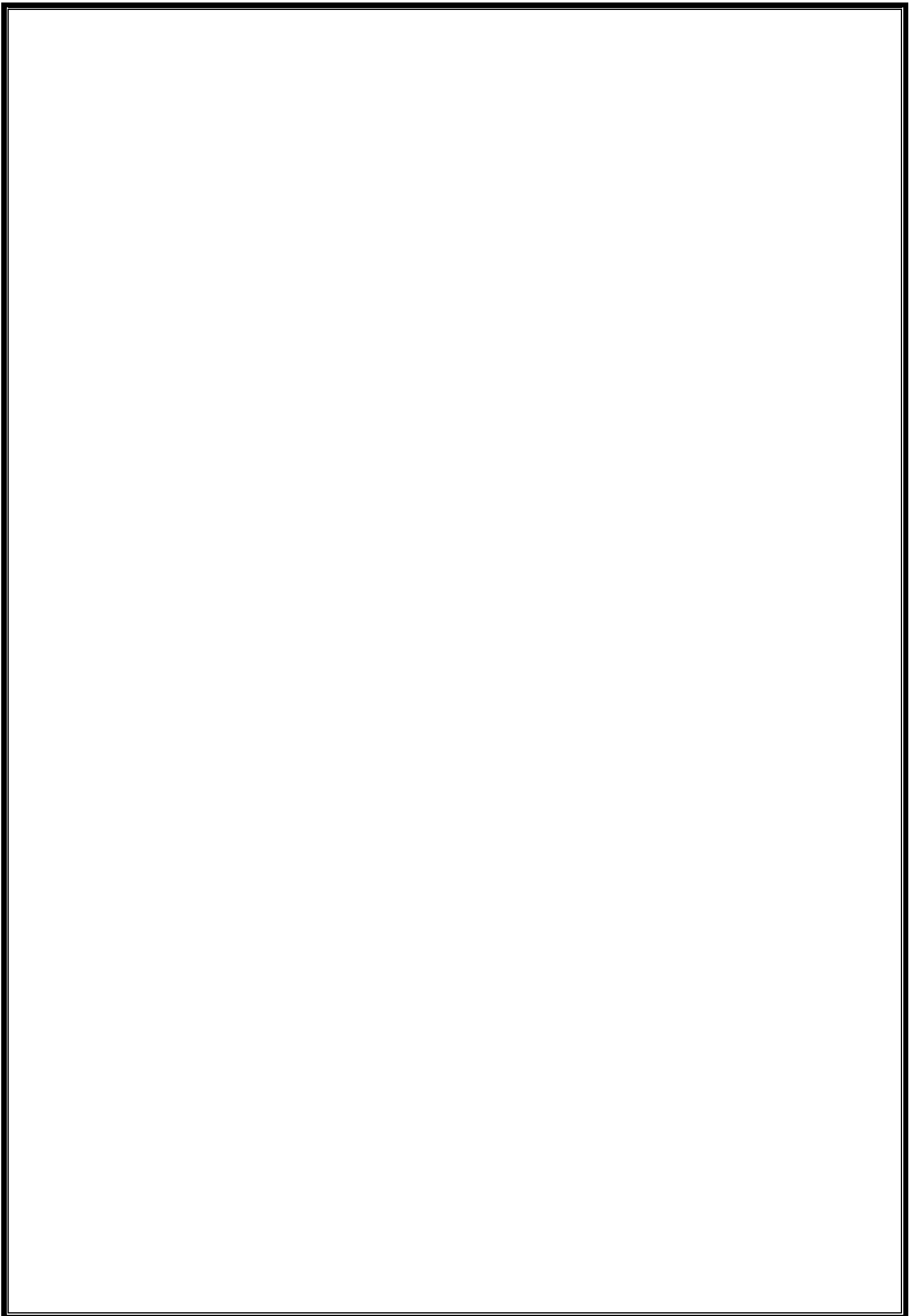

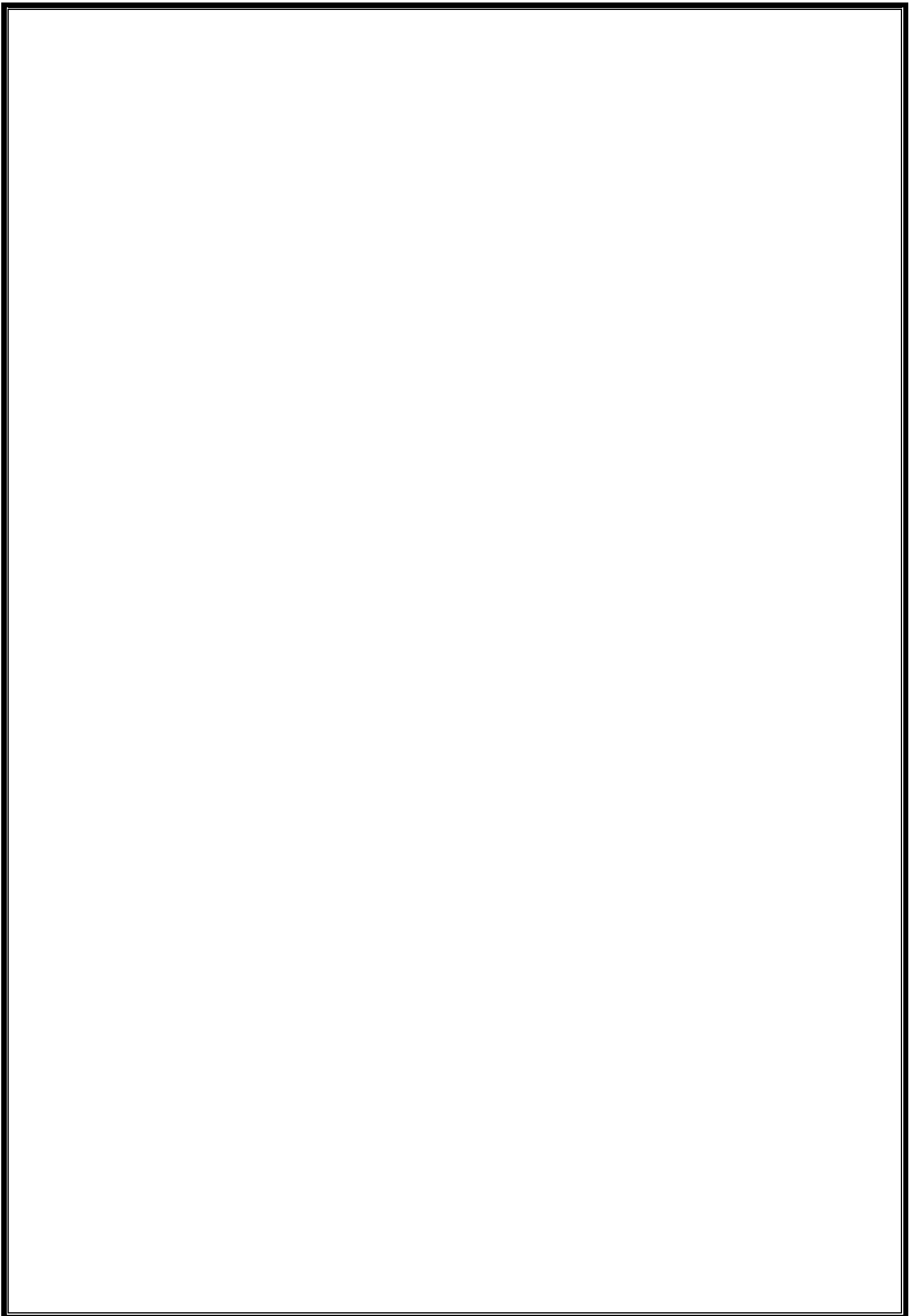

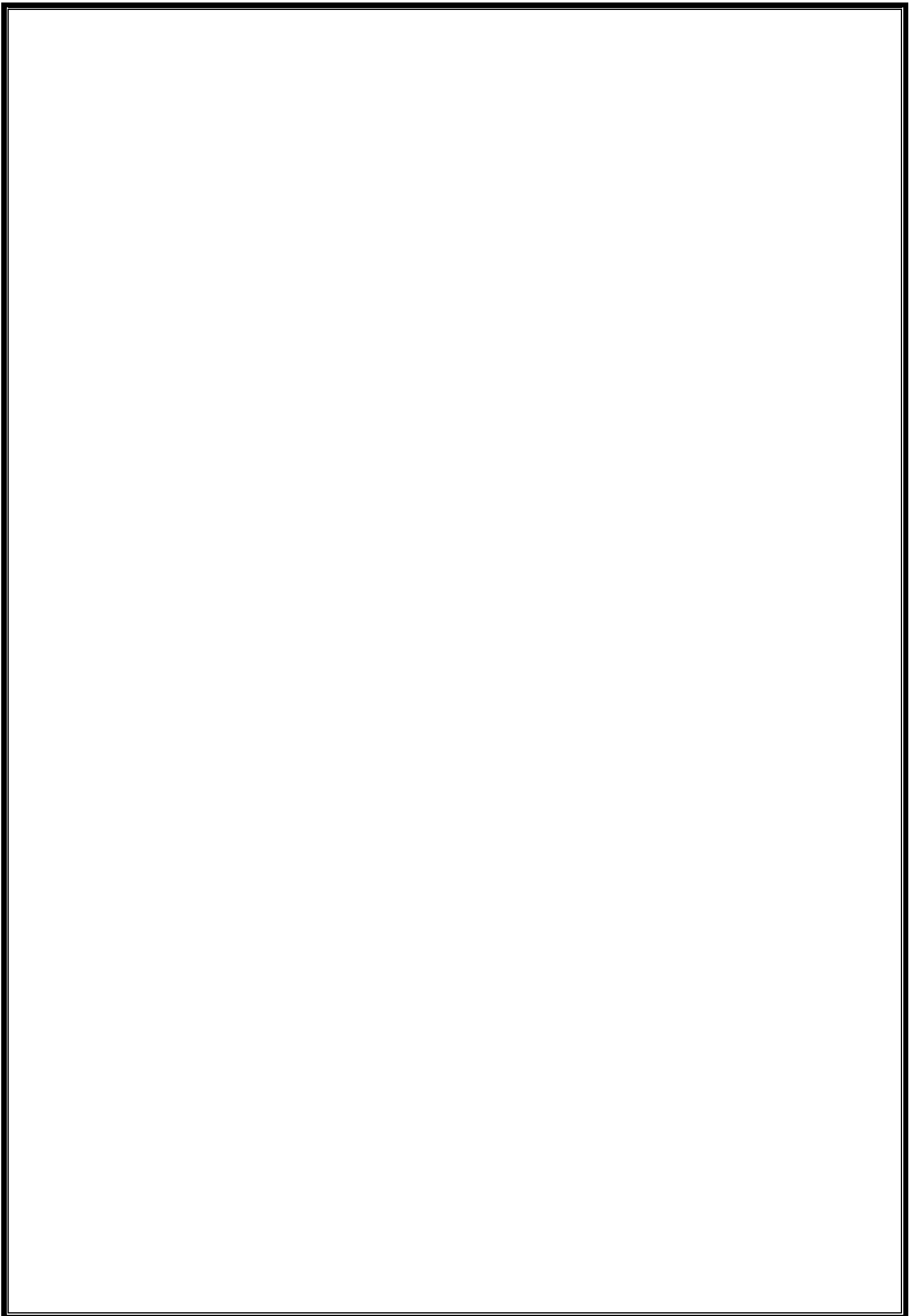


Distribution of Food



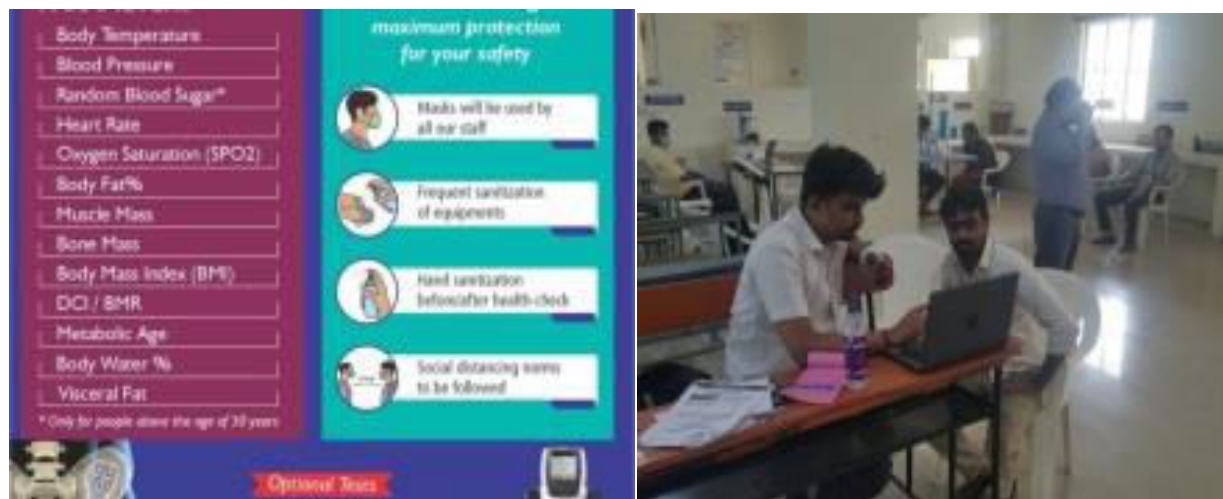

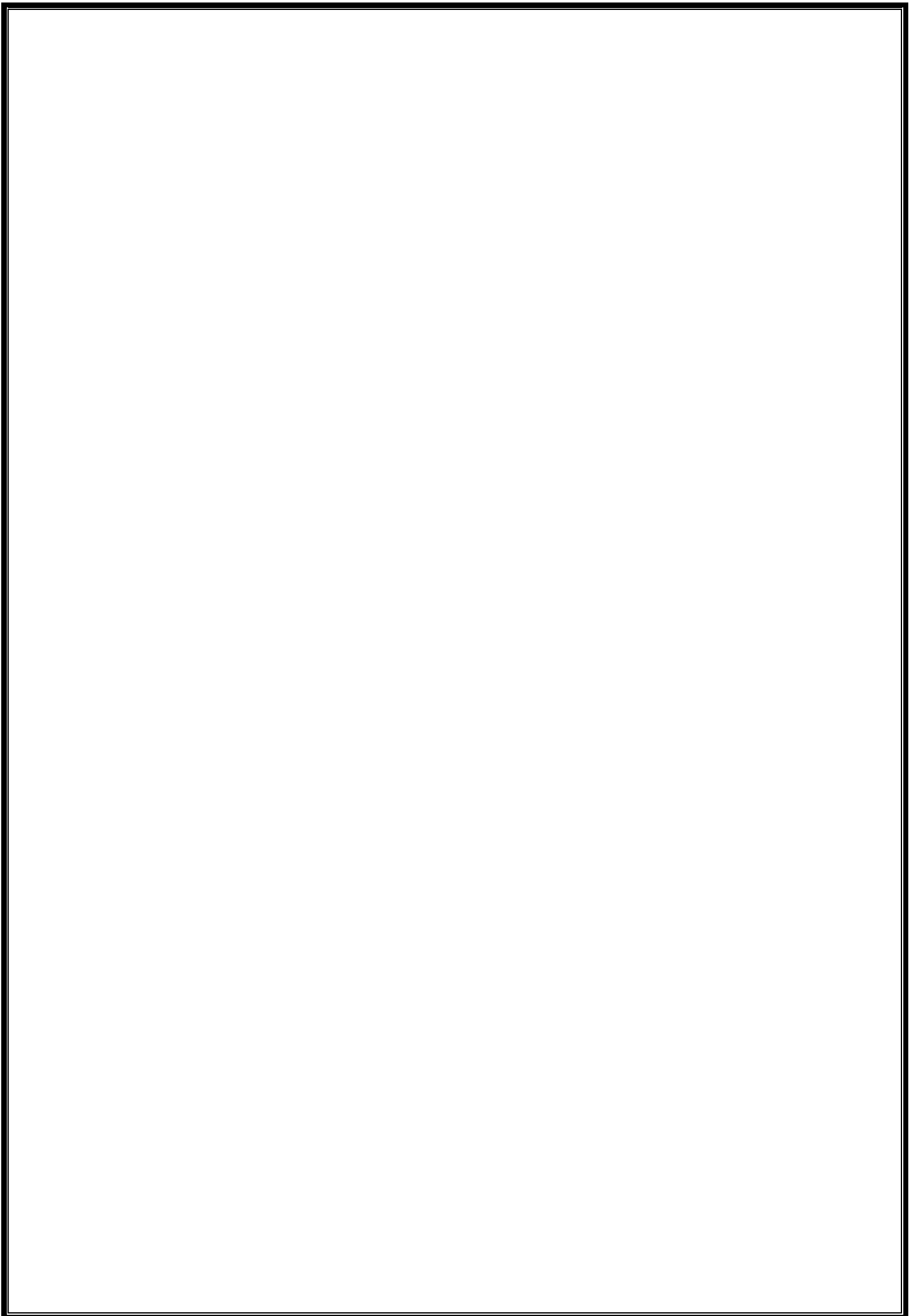
