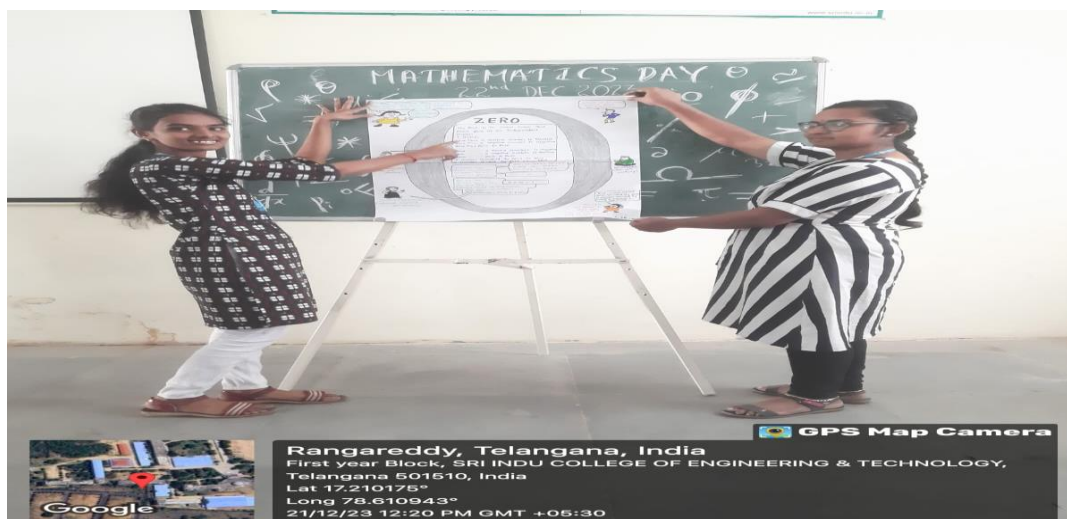

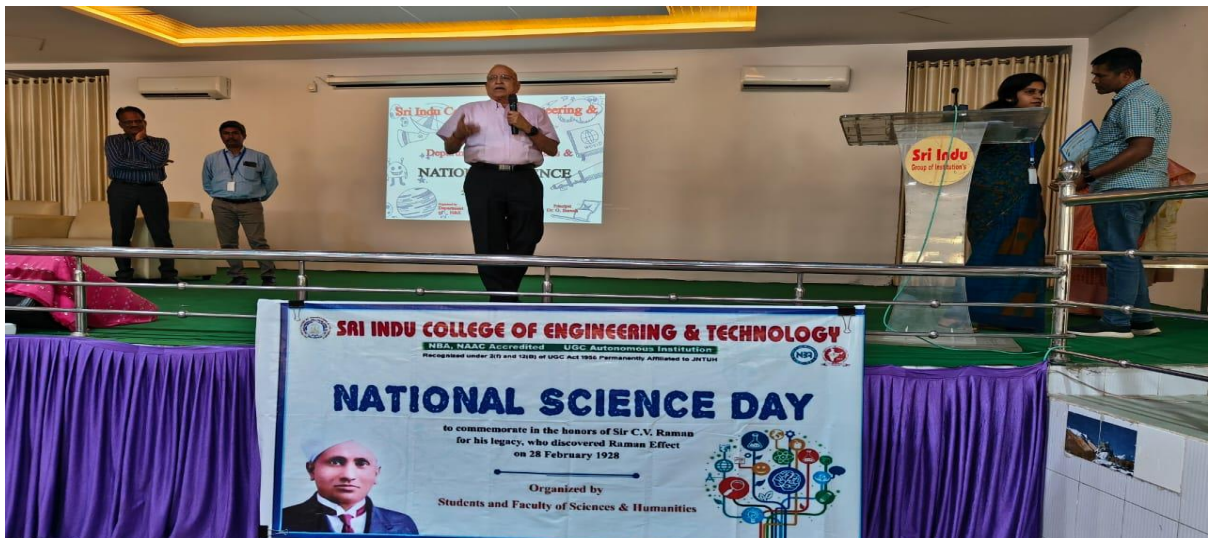

National Science Day

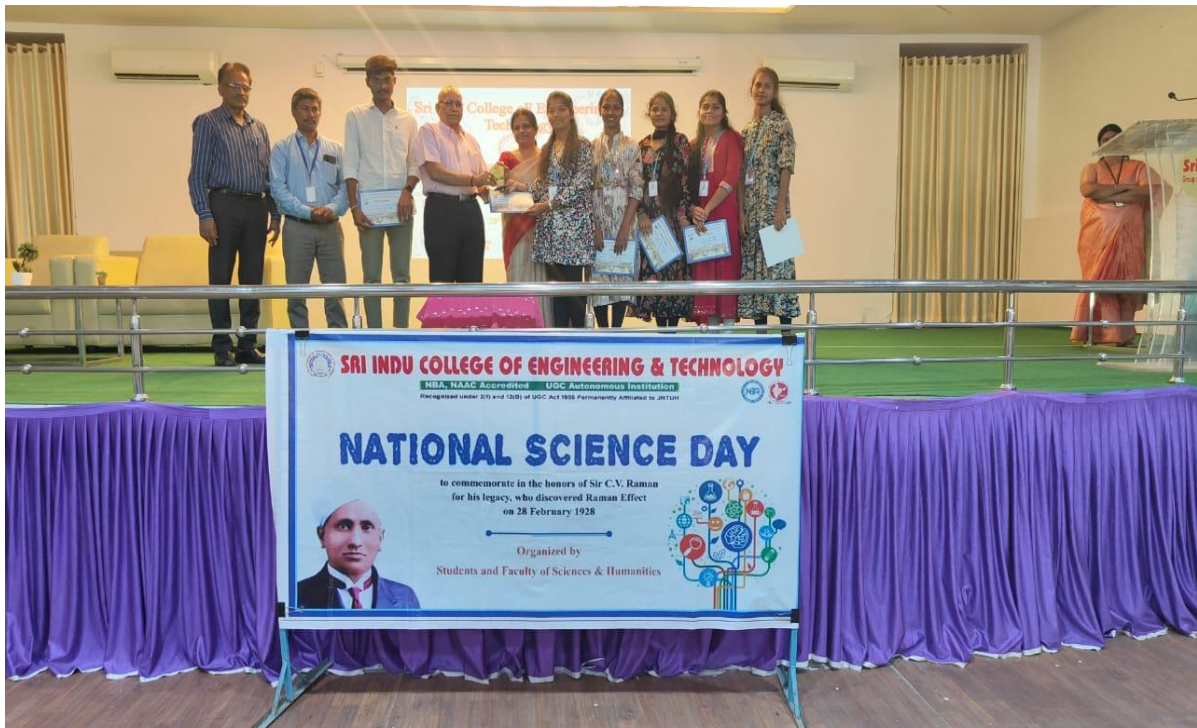

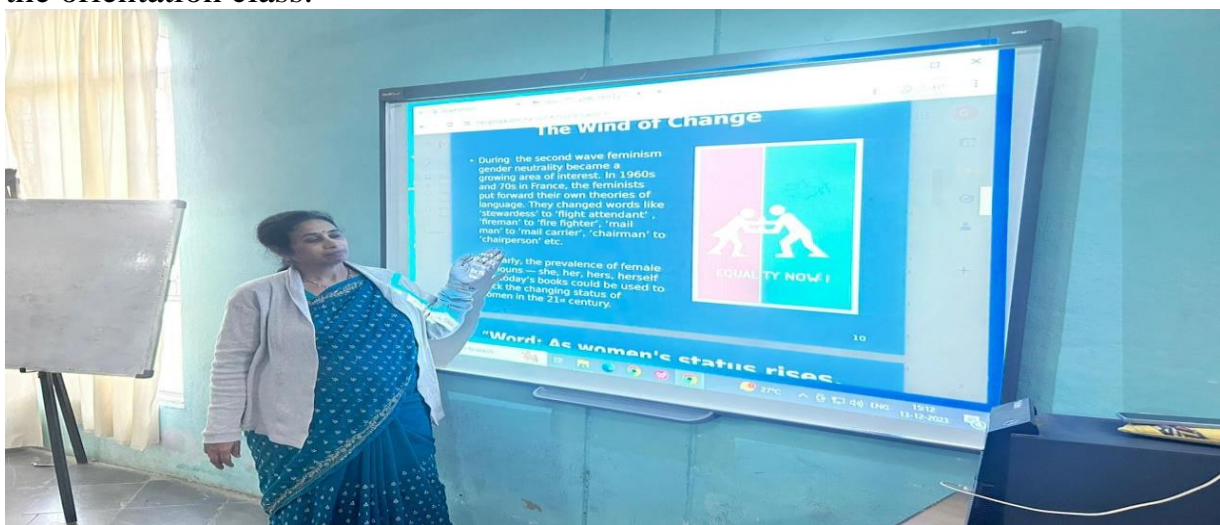
